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∴ ORDERS ON IA NO. V ∴

This is the application No. V filed by the defendant No.4 to 7 permission to file his written statement of this suit. In the affidavit It is averred to the application. originally the plaintiff has filed suit for the relief of permanent injunction against defendants in respect of suit schedule property. It is also averred that due to non availability of the documents. defendant could not contact their counsel to instruct to him to filed written statement as such written statement on his behalf could be filed in this case. The delay in non filing of written statement is not intentional. If this application is allowed know hardship will be caused to plaintiff. Per contra if this application is not allowed the defendants will put to grate hardship before pray to allow the application in interest of justice. On receipt of application learned counsel submitted no objection to the IA. On the basis of the application and objection filed following points arise for my consideration.

1. Whether the defendants No.4 to 7 have made out sufficient ground to allow this application ?
2. What order?
3. My answer to the above point is as under.

Point no.1:- In the Affirmative.

REASONS

Point no.1:- At the outset it is the suit for the relief of permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule property against defendants. Hence under such circumstances the right of the parties needs to be adjudicated, as such they need to be given an opportunity to defend their right suit property. Further on perusal of order sheet, defendant no. 4 to 7 were impleaded on 24-03-2025 and have appeared through his counsel on 03-01-2026 but all these days they have not filed written statement. As such, if application as prayed for is allowed, there will be delay in proceedings. But only delay in filing the written statement shall not deny the opportunity to defendant to defend their right with respect of suit property. As such in my view by imposing suitable cost, the defendants can be permitted to file their written statement. Hence, the defendants have made out sufficient ground to allow this application. Accordingly I answer to the point no.1 in the Affirmative.

Point no.2:- In view of discussion arrived at point no.1 IA no. V deserves to be allowed. Hence I proceed to pass the following,
