Report of the SHO concerned received and perused. Heard on the application for release of vehicle bearing registration No. PB-65-AH-(T)-9860, in favour of the applicant on superdari. As per the report of the local police the said vehicle bearing No. PB-65-AH-(T)-9860, is lying in the police malkhana and local police has no objection if the vehicle in question is released on superdari to the real/registered owner. Heard. Since the local police has no objection in releasing the vehicle in favour of real/registered owner, therefore, in view of the report of police, the vehicle is ordered to be released to the applicant/superdar on her furnishing of Superdarinama in the sum of ₹30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) with one surety in the like amount with the condition that he will not alienate the same and will not change the colour or condition of the vehicle and will produce it on date of hearing whenever directed to do so. The SHO concern is directed to make proper punchnama of the above-said **vehicle** and also take **copy of RC** of the vehicle in question and same be submitted before the Court for the proper identification and trial. Requisite bonds not furnished.
