3. Whether the plaintiff proves that, no partition took place between him and defendant No.1 in the suit properties by meets and bounds?
4. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the suit of the plaintiff is not maintainable without inclusion of house plot bearing No.532 of Ganadhal village ?
5. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that suit of the plaintiff is bad for non joinder of necessary parties to the suit ?
6. Whether the defendant No.1 proves that the suit property bearing RS No.31/* /6 measuring 2 acres 30 guntas of Ganadhal village is the self acquired property of his and it was sold for family necessities and for clearing of loans ?
7. Whether the defendant No. 1 proves that suit of plaintiff is barred by law of limitation ?

8. Whether the plaintiff is entitled the share in the suit properties ?
9. What order or decree?
