ORDERS ON IA NO. II

Case Called out. Defendant no. 2 to 6 are present. Sri. S.S.P. advocate filed vakalath and IA no. II U/o 9 Rule 7 of CPC Praying to set aside exparte order against Defendant No. 2, 3, 5 and 6. Other side counsel filed objection to the IA.

In the affidavit it is stated that the defendant No. 2, 3, 5 and 6 due to unavoidable circumstances could not appear and appointed advocate in time. Hence this court took the appearance of defendant No. 2, 3, 5 and 6 as nil and placed exparte. On perusal of the order sheet on the previous date of hearing the summons was served on 27-11-2025 and IA is filed on 18-12-2025 no harm or injury would cause to the other side if the IA is allowed. On the other hand great injustice would cause to the applicant. By applying principles of natural justice. IA deserves to be allowed.

Hence the following:

ORDER

IA no. II filed by the defendant No. 2, 3, 5 and 6 counsel U/o 9 rule 7 of CPC is hereby allowed on cost of Rupees 100/- to be paid to TLSC Devadurga and submit the receipt. Exparte order recalled.

Counsel for plaintiff filed memo stating that, the name of defendant no. 1 is Dodda Siddappa urf Siddalingappa. Hence issue S/S to the defendant no. 1 as stated in the memo if PF paid at office Rby 17-01-2026 for W.S.
