3. Whether the plaintiffs proves that, defendant no.3 and 4 without the consent and knowledge of the plaintiff has illegally got mutated suit property and the said mutation order is not binding upon the plaintiff ?
4. Whether the defendant no.3 and 4 proves that, the father of plaintiff by name Yankappa S/o Gangappa had 4 daughters and 3 sons and the plaintiff have left the 04 daughters by name Iramma, Paguntamma, Renukamma and Nagamma in the G-tree and they are necessary party to the suit?
5. Whether the defendant no. 3 and 4 proves that there was oral partition between the ancestral plaintiff and defendant and they RTC is standing in the name of defendant more than 30 years and suit is barred by law of limitation ?
6. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to relief of partition and rectification of ROR ?
7. What order or decree ?
