The petition filed on 27.09.2022 before this Hon'ble Court against the Respondents U/Sec.166 of MV Act, as per details mentioned in the petition and prays the Hon'ble court may be pleased to grant compensation of Rs.20,00,000/- with court costs, interest at 18% PA from the date of accident till realization and grant such other relief/s in the interest of justice and equity.

This petition coming on this day for final disposal before Sri.Mahendra.M, B.A., LL.B., Senior Civil Judge and MACT, Malavalli, in the presence of Sri.H.V.P., Advocate for petitioner, Sri.H.L., Advocate for Respondent No.1 and Sri.S.B., Advocate for Respondent No.2.

By accepting the terms of compromise memo petition is disposed off. It is ordered and decreed that, the 2nd respondent has agreed to settle the dispute for Rs.3,60,000/- payable to the petitioner and also put his signature to the joint memo. Accordingly, they have filed a Joint compromise memo requesting to dispose off the case in terms of compromise.

Further, it is ordered and decreed that, I have gone through the contents of the joint memo. Read-over and explained the same to the petitioner. They have accepted the contents and terms of the compromise as correct. Hence the joint memo is accepted and the case is disposed off accordingly.

Further, it is ordered and decreed that, The 2nd Respondent is directed to deposit the settlement amount of Rs.3,60,000/- in the court within 3 months. In the event of failure to deposit the amount within the time, the 2nd respondent is liable to pay the interest at the rate 6% per annum till the date of payment.

In the event of deposit, the petitioner is entitled to get release the entire amount.
