

ORDER

Learned counsel for the Plaintiff present. In the present suit the plaintiff has valued the suit to the extent of Rs. 7,00,000/- of her share. In view of recent amendment to Karnataka Civil court (amendment) Act and in view of recent judgment of Hon'ble High court of Karnataka, Kalaburagi bench in W.P No.201536/2024 (GM-RES) dated 24-09-2025. in the said judgment Honble High court of Karnataka, Kalaburagi bench held that, amendment to the Karnataka Civil court Act (Act No.33/2024) shall be prospective effect. It is also held that, all other amendments to the Karnataka Civil courts Act amended by way of amendment Act, 2023 (Karnataka Act No.33/2024) are up held. As per order number LAW-LCE/242/2023 Bengaluru dated 24-06-2024, the amended provisions of Karnataka Civil Courts (Amendment) Act, 2023 (Karnataka Act No.33/2024) shall operate with effect from 19-06-2024. The plaintiff has filed the suit on 19-09-2024 and valuation of the suit is Rs.7,00,000/-. In the

said judgment at para No. 2 Honble High court of Karnataka, Kalaburagi bench held that, in Sec.17 of the Karnataka Civil courts amended Act, 2023, Five lakhs is substituted by the word Fifteen lakhs. Thus, it is clear that this court has no pecuniary jurisdiction to try any suit of its value of Rs.15,00,000/- or below. Hence, I pass the following; ORDER Office is directed to return the plaint along with all the documents filed by the plaintiff, to the plaintiff forthwith. Plaintiff is directed to take plaint from the office and submit it before the learned Civil Judge court, Manvi within limitation period.
