

Complainant present.

Accused present.

Learned counsel for complainant filed memo stating that the accused paid the compromise amount and compromised the case. Hence, prays for dismissal of the case as settled.

In the compromise memo it is submitted that the complainant and accused have compromised the case. Further it is submitted that the complainant has received the compromised amount from the accused. Hence, prays for dismissal of the complaint as settled between the parties.
