**ISSUES**

- 1)** Whether the plaintiffs prove that themselves and defendant No.1 are members of Hindu Undivided joint family and suit schedule property are their joint properties?
- 2)** Whether plaintiffs prove that sale deeds dated 16-09-2004, 20-02-2006, 30-10-2007, 05-12-2007, 30-04-2010, 07-06-2011 and 30-10-2018 are concocted and obtained in the circumstances narrated in the para 9 of the plaint and as such same are not binding to them?
- 3)** Whether defendant No.17 and 18 proves that the defendant No.1 has sold "B" and "C" suit schedule properties for joint family necessities?
- 4)** Whether the defendant No.20 proves that the defendant No.1 has sold "G" suit schedule property in his favour under registered sale deed dated 05-12-2007 for his family necessities?
- 5)** Whether the defendant No.15 proves that the defendant No.1 has sold "A" suit schedule property in his favour under registered sale deed dated 16-09-2004 for his family necessities?

- 6)** Whether the defendant No.15, 17, 18 and 20 prove that they are bonafide purchasers of “A” to “C” and “G” suit schedule properties respectively?
- 7)** Whether suit is barred by limitation?
- 8)** Whether suit is bad for partial partition?
- 9)** Whether plaintiffs are entitle for share in the suit schedule properties? If so, to what share they are entitled?
- 10)** What order or decree?
