

Application U/sec 442 of  
BNSS filed on behalf of Petitioner

to stay the release of frozen amount.

Heard on behalf of Petitioner and perused the orders in Cr No. 24/2026 dated 20.02.2026 whereby an amount of Rs.80,000/- is ordered to be released to the interim custody to the applicant and she executing the indemnity bond on condition.

As per the petition averments the Cyber Crime Police, Bengaluru south had sought for de-freezing the amount from the Petitioner account to the account of the complainant. The said amount with regard to purchase of gold coin of 5 grams from the Petitioner Jewellery shop so, if the amount is debited from the Petitioner account and transfer to the debtor account and mental stress so the main prayer in the petition in to call for the records in Cr No.24/2026 and set aside the order passed in I Addl. Senior civil judge, Ramanagara and to stay the order of impugned order

pending disposal of the revision petition.

If the petition prayer taken into consideration, whereby revision is sought against the order of release of the amount to the interim custody of the complainant. Whether the amount belongs to complainant or the Petitioner if the fact which has to be tried and adjudicated to make out who is guilty of the offence. Petitioner claims that it is a genuine transaction. There is a condition that if complainant\ applicant is not entitled for the freezed amount he shall deposit in the name of the court whenever called for. So in the event if the court come to the conclusion that, the applicant is not entitled then the recovery will lead to multiple proceeding. Hence, if the operation of the order is stayed by directing to deposit the said amount of Rs.80,000/- to be deposited in the court and kept in FD in any nationalized Bank till final disposal of the case, then it will meet the

ends of justice. Hence, I proceed  
to pass the following:

**ORDER**

Application filed on behalf of Petitioner U/sec 442 of BNS is allowed.

The operation of the orders in Cr.No.24/2026 dated 20.02.2026 is stayed until further orders and petitioner is directed to deposit the amount of Rs.80,000/- in the court to be kept in FD of any nationalized Bank till final disposal of the case.

On deposit of the amount Petitioner shall produce necessary documents before the court.

Issue notice to Respondent by 27.05.2026.
