

ORDER BELOW EXH. 01 IN R.C.S. NO.91/ 2022 :-

Both parties and their advocate are present today before National Lok Adalat. They filed pursis at Exh.23 and exh.24 stating that they have settled the matter and thus they want to dispose off the present suit in terms of conditions mentioned in pursis at Exh.23. The settlement agreement at Exh.23 is not void. It is seen that the present suit is mutually settled before the National Lokadalak. As per Order XXIII, Rule 3 of the Code of Civil Procedure,1908, it would be proper to record the compromise/settlement mentioned in compromise pursis at Exh.23 as the settlement agreement at Exh.23 is not void. Hence, in view of settlement agreement pursis at Exh.23 to Exh.24 and order thereon, following order is passed.

i.] In view of settlement agreement pursis at Exh.23 to Exh.24 this suit bearing R.C.S. no.91/2022 is disposed off as it is settled before the National Lokadalat.

ii.] The settlement agreement between the parties to this case vide Exh.23 shall be governed by Section 21 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987.

iii.] The decree be drawn up in terms of settlement agreement at Exh.23 as per Order XXIII Rule 3 of the Civil Procedure Code,1908.

iv.] Court fee be refunded as per rules and issue Court-fee refund certificate accordingly.
