

The counsel for plaintiff has filed I.A U/o 6 Rule 17 r/w Sec.151 of CPC., to amend the plaint as mentioned in the application.

Sufficient opportunity is given to the defendant to file objection to the above said I.A. Hence, objection of defendant to I.A is taken as not filed.

Perused I.A. and it is satisfied that the proposed amendment would not change the nature of the suit nor introduces a new case or new cause of action. As such the application deserves to be allowed to avoid multiplicity of proceedings. Accordingly, the Court proceeds to pass the following;
