

Heard the Plaintiffs counsel and perused the records.

The documents produced by the plaintiffs, at this pre-trial stage establishes that the plaintiffs have got prima facie case to go for trial.

Hence this court views that, if notice on I.A-1 is issued to the defendants it may lead to multiplicity of suits. Hence to prevent multiplicity of suits, notice on I.A No.1 has to be dispensed with. Hence, with this observation this court proceeds to pass the following:-

### **ORDER**

I.A No.1 application filed by the plaintiffs U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Exparte temporary injunction order is hereby granted against the defendant No.2, his agents, servants, supporters, followers or anybody claiming under him by restraining him from temporarily alienating the suit schedule property till next date of hearing.

Issue ex parte temporary injunction order against defendant No.2 and suit summons to the defendants No.1 to 15, if the plaintiffs complies with order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.
