The document produced by the plaintiff i.e., Genealogical Tree, certified Copy of Sale Deeds dated 31.03.1945 & 17.05.1945,

certified copies of RCT Extracts (Sy.No.43, 44, 93, 94, 99/6, 99/1, 102) Xerox copy of Ration Cards and Mutation Extracts, at this pre-trial stage establishes that the plaintiff has got prima facie case to go for trial.

Hence this court views that, if notice on I.A.II is issued to the defendants it may lead to multiplicity of suits. Hence, to prevent multiplicity of suits, notice on I.A No.II has to be dispensed with. Hence, with this observation this court proceeds to pass the following:-

ORDER

I.A No.I application filed by the plaintiff U/o.39 Rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

I.A No.II application filed by the plaintiff U/o.39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Ex-parte temporary injunction order is hereby granted against the defendant, **his** agents, servants, supporters, followers or anybody claiming under him by restraining him from temporarily alienating the suit schedule property, till next date of hearing.

Issue ex-parte temporary injunction order and suit summons to the defendant, if the plaintiff complies with order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.
