

Heard the Plaintiff counsel and perused the records.

The documents produced by the plaintiff, at this pre-trial stage establishes that the plaintiff has got prima facie case to go for trial.

Hence this court views that, if notice on I.A-1 is issued to the defendants it may lead to multiplicity of suits. Hence to prevent multiplicity of suits, notice on I.A No.1 has to be dispensed with. Hence, with this observation this court proceeds to pass the following:-

ORDER

I.A No.2 application filed by the plaintiff seeking dispensation of Notice on I.A.1 is hereby allowed.

I.A.1 application filed U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC is hereby allowed. Exparte temporary injunction is hereby granted against the defendant No.12, his agents, servants or anybody claiming under him by restraining him from temporarily alienating the suit schedule property, till next date of hearing.

Issue ex parte temporary injunction order to defendant No.12 by RPAD and suit summons to the defendants No.1 to 8 & 10 and to defendants No.9 & 11 by RPAD, if the plaintiff complies with order 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.
