2. Whether the Plaintiffs prove the existence of the joint family?
3. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 proves that the suit schedule 'A', 'C', 'D', 'G' to 'M', 'P' and 'Q' properties are the self acquired properties of the propositus Channappa @ Gopalli Channappa?
4. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that already there is a partition taken place by the kartha of the then joint family orally and thereafter byway of panchayath parikath?

5. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that the suit schedule 'B' property is the self acquired property of Madaiah @ Channappa?
6. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that the suit schedule 'E' and 'F' properties are the self acquired properties of Mahadevaiah S/o Venkatappa?
7. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that the suit schedule 'P' and 'Q' properties were allotted to the share of Venkatappa and Kalyanamma?
8. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that the suit schedule item 'O', 'R' and 'S' properties are the self acquired properties of Madaiah and Venkatappa?
9. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that the suit schedule item No."T" property is the self acquired property of Venkatappa S/o Gopalli Channappa?
10. Whether the Defendants No.2 to 8 prove that the suit schedule item No."U" property is the self acquired property of Kalyanamma and Venkatappa by virtue of the order passed in LRF No.741/1974-75?
11. Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?

12. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled to the relief of partition and separate possession of their share as prayed for?
