2. Whether the Plaintiff proves that the Defendants and he are in in joint possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property?
3. Whether the Plaintiff proves that the father of the Defendant No.3, him and late Rajanna purchased the suit schedule property from the joint family funds through the registered sale deed dated:25.04.1967?
4. Whether the Defendants No.1 to 3 prove that there was a partition in respect of the ancestral properties among the Plaintiff, the Defendant No.3, late Rajanna and their father late Muniyappa on 10.01.1989?
5. Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties and properties?

6. Whether the Defendants No.1 to 3 prove that the suit schedule property was the self-acquired property of late Muniyappa through registered sale deed dated:21.04.1967?
7. Whether the Defendants No.1 to 3 prove that late Muniyappa has bequeathed the suit schedule property and the property in Sy.No.65/1B of Avarergere Village to an extent of 2 acres 10 guntas by virtue of the registered Will dated:05.12.2014 in favour of the Defendants No.1 and 2?
8. Whether the Defendants No.1 to 3 prove that the Defendants No.1 and 2 are the absolute owners of the suit schedule property by virtue of the registered Will dated:05.12.2014?
9. Whether the Plaintiff proves the alleged interference by the Defendants?
10. Whether the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief of partition as prayed for?
11. Whether the Plaintiff is entitled to the relief of permanent injunction as prayed for?
12. Whether the Plaintiff is entitled to the reliefs as sought for?
13. What Order or Decree?
