

Later both parties are present. On request made by Sri.K.V.Y., Advocate for defendant case records taken before National Lok-Adalat.

Both parties submit that on 19.09.2024 compromise petition was filed signed by both parties and their Advocate and for want of survey sketch it was kept in abeyance.

I have perused the case records it is noticed that on 19.09.2024 a compromise petition signed by both parties and their Advocate was filed before the court. On 26.05.2025 memo with survey sketch has also been furnished. I have perused the RTC for the year 2020-21, from which it reveals that out of 7 acre 20 guntas 2 acre 20 guntas is A kharab which is part and parcel of cultivable land. The contents of the compromise petition dated 19.09.2024 are read over and explained to both parties in Kannada in the language known to them, they have accepted the same to be true and correct. Compromise is in accordance with law. Hence, compromise petition dated 19.09.2024 is accepted. Suit is decreed in terms of the

compromise petition before
