3. Whether the Plaintiffs prove that the Defendants and they are in joint possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule properties?
4. Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties as contended in the written statement of the Defendant No.8?
5. Whether the Defendant No.8 proves that the wife of the Defendant No.3 is the owner of the suit schedule item No.1 property by virtue of sale deed?

6. Whether the Defendant No.8 further proves that there is a already partition in respect of the suit schedule item No.2 property among the children of S.N.Thimmaiah as contended in para No.13 of his written statement?
7. Whether the Defendant No.13 proves that his father was the absolute owner in respect of the suit schedule item No.3 property by virtue of the registered sale deed dated 13-09-1962?
8. Whether the Defendant No.3 proves that she is the absolute owner of the suit schedule item No.3 property by virtue of the registered partition deed dated 14-07-2021?
9. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for partition and separate possession of the suit schedule properties?
10. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for the relief/s as sought for?
11. What Order or Decree?
