

The plaintiff advocate has filed the suit for the relief of partition and separate possession with respect to the suit schedule properties against the defendants. The present IA is filed for the exparte ad-interim temporary injunction by the plaintiff.

The plaintiff counsel sought for the order not to alienate the suit schedule properties.

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff and perused the records.

The plaintiff counsel has filed G-Tree, Photo Copies of RTC Extract, copy of E.C, copy of Aadhar Card., and also perused the same. The documents produced by the plaintiff at this stage establish that, the plaintiff has made-out a prima-facie case to go for trial. Therefore, it is necessary to restrain the defendants by an order of Exparte Temporary Injunction from alienating the suit schedule properties. Hence, the following:-

ORDER

The Defendant is restrained by an exparte order of temporary injunction from alienating the suit schedule properties to the 3rd party, till the next date of hearing.

The Plaintiff is directed to comply with Order XXXIX Rule 3 of CPC.

Issue notice of Ex-parte order of temporary injunction on IA No.I along with the suit summons to the Defendants.
