

Perused the unregistered panchayath parikath dated 1986. The advocate has raised the objection is that, it cannot be admitted as it is unregistered and not properly stamped and the year is rectified. So, if the advocate for the plaintiff is directed to pay the stamp duty and penalty, no hardship will be caused to the other side.

On the other hand, the advocate for the defendant has got every right and opportunity to cross examine the witnesses of the parikath at the Trial in respect of the year and can prove his defense to the said document.

Accordingly, objection is rejected and plaintiff advocate is directed to pay the stamp duty and penalty.

Office is directed to issue intimation to the Sub-registrar for payment of stamp duty and penalty.
