

INTERIM ORDER ON IA NO.I & II

Heard the counsel for plaintiff on I.A.No.I & II.

Under the I.A.No.I the plaintiff prayed for an order of temporary injunction against the defendants to restrain them from alienating the suit schedule properties.

Under the I.A.No.II the plaintiff prayed for an order of temporary injunction against the defendants to restrain them from not to interfere with the agricultural activities and to maintain status-quo over the suit schedule properties.

It is the contention of the plaintiff that the plaintiff has got share in the suit schedule properties. The plaintiff has produced documents which shows that as on the date of execution of the Sale Deed in favour of defendant No.9, she was major. But she was shown as minor. Therefore, there are merits in the contention of the plaintiff. Hence, nature of the properties must be preserved, till the rights of the plaintiff is decided. Hence, in order to avoid multiplicity of proceedings

an temporary injunction has to be issued against the defendants as prayed in the I.A.No.I and Order of Status-quo as prayed in I.A.No.II.

Hence, I pass the following;

ORDER

The defendants are hereby temporarily restrained from alienating the schedule properties till further orders.

I.A.No.II is allowed. Both the parties are directed to maintain status-quo with regard to suit schedule properties till further orders.
