**ORDER ON BAIL APPLICATION UNDER  
SECTION 436 OF CR.P.C.**

The Advocate for accused is has filed bail application Under Section 436 of Cr.P.C. It is stated in the application that the complainant has filed false case against the accused. The accused has not committed any offence as alleged. The accused is innocent and permanent resident at Alur Taluk, Hassan District.
