The Plaintiff, the Defendant No. 2(a) to (c), Defendant No. 3 to 5 present and Learned counsel for Plaintiff and Defendants are present. Defendant No. 1 is dead and is represented by his Lrs that is Plaintiff, Defendant No. 2(a) to (c), Defendant No. 3 and 4.

Both the parties have filed joint compromise petition. The same is treated as joint memo.

The Plaintiff and the said Defendants have signed the joint memo petition.

The Plaintiff and the said Defendant have stated in the Joint memo that they have amicably settled the disputes and they have voluntarily entered in to compromise.

We have enquired parties and they have stated that they have voluntarily entered into compromise. Cheques are handed over to parties before us.

We have specifically enquired Defendant No. 3 not being given any money in the settlement, she submits she was already a signatory to the sale deed and therefore she doesn't wan money now. The same is placed on record.

As the terms of joint memo are lawful and as there is no impediment to accept the joint memo, the joint memo is accepted.
