J U D G M E N T

This suit is for the relief of declaration seeking direction to the defendants with regard to the change of plaintiff's father and mother name as "C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary" instead of "Loordh Anandan.C.J" and "Aroky Mary" in the concerned register and for costs and such other reliefs.

2. The brief facts of the plaintiff's case are as under:

The plaintiff has stated that, he is the permanent resident of the cause title address. His father and mother name is "C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary". He has studied 1st standard to 7th standard in the institution of defendant No.4, 8th standard at defendant No.5, 9th and 10th standard at defendant No.6 and PUC at defendant No.7.

It is further submitted that, his father's and mother's original name is "C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary" but at the time of admission of the school, his father and mother name was wrongly entered as "Loordh Anandan.C.J" and "Arokya Mary" instead of "C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary". The said mistake has to be rectified from all the school records of plaintiff. Unless and until the names of father and mother of plaintiff is not rectified, he will be put to severe hardship. It is just and necessary to change the names of father

and mother of the plaintiff to avoid issues during the course of job and other correspondences.

It is further submitted that, he has also got issued statutory notice of 60 days U/s 80(2) of CPC for all the defendants on 22.08.2023 but none of the defendants have replied till today and that the cause of action for the suit arose on 22.08.2023 and he has got issued statutory notice of 60 days U/s 80(2) of CPC to all the defendants. Hence, this suit.

3. In pursuant to service of summons to defendants, the defendants did not appear before the court and placed exparte.

4. The points that arise for the consideration of this court is as under;

1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relief as claimed for?
2. What Order or Decree?

5. In order to prove the case, the plaintiff got himself examined on oath as PW-1 and led his examination-in-chief in lieu of affidavit and got marked 14 documents as Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.14 and supporting witness of the plaintiff got examined on oath as PW.2 but no documents was marked on behalf of PW.2 and closed their side of evidence. Defendants has placed exapрте. Hence, cross-examination of PW.1 and 2 is taken as Nil.

6. Heard arguments and perused the oral and documentary evidence available on record.

7. The answer to the above points are as follows;

Point No.1 : In the Affirmative
Point No.2 : As per Final Order
for the following;

REASONS

8. **Point No.1:** On perusal of materials on record, it is asserted in the plaint by the plaintiff that, his father and mother original name is “C.J.Jayaraju” and “Arikyamary” but at the time of admission of the school,

his father and mother name was wrongly entered as “Loordh Anandan.C.J” and “Arokya Mary” instead of “C.J.Jayaraju” and “Arikyamary”. The said mistake are to be rectified from all the school records of plaintiff. Unless and until the names of father and mother of plaintiff is not rectified, he will be put to severe hardship. It is just and necessary to change the names of father and mother of the plaintiff to avoid issues during the course of job and other correspondences.

9. In order to prove the case the plaintiff has got himself examined as PW-1 on oath and lead his examination-in-chief in lieu of affidavit and reiterated all the plaint averments. In support of his case he got marked 14 documents as Ex.P.1 to Ex.P.14. Ex.P.1 is the Seventh Marks card, Ex.P.2 is the SSLC marks card, Ex.P.3 is the I P.U.C Marks card, Ex.p.4 is the study certificate issued by Santaritha Higher Primary School, Kanakapura dated 25.05.2023, Ex.p.5 is the study certificate issued by defendant No.6 dated 27.05.2023,

Ex.p.6 is the transfer certificate issued by defendant No.6, Ex.p.7 is the study certificate issued by defendant No.5 dated 25.05.2023, Ex.p.8 is the original pan card of PW.1, Ex.p.9 is the Voter ID of PW.1, Ex.p.10 is the aadhar card of PW.1, Ex.p.11 is the aadhar card of the mother of the PW.1, Ex.p.12 is the aadhar card of father of the plaintiff, Ex.p.13 is the Voter ID card of father of the plaintiff and Ex.p.14 pan card of the father of the plaintiff and on the basis of these documents, the plaintiff prays to decree the suit.

10. All these documents i.e., Ex.P.10 to Ex.p.14 if considered cumulatively they show that name of plaintiff's father and mother name as "C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary" and Ex.P.1 to 9 reflect that, name of father's and mother's name is wrongly entered in the school records as well as in his pan card and voter I.D card. However, now he intends to rectify the same in his school records which would assist him to rectify the said aspect in his other documents subsequently. Since defendants

have neither filed written statement nor have made any efforts to contradict the stand of plaintiff in the above case and on the basis of available documents on records, there is nothing found to disbelieve the case of plaintiff. If the suit is decreed no harm or injury will be caused to anybody and also materials are in corroborative with the averments made by the plaintiff. Hence, on perusal of the entire evidence, this Court comes to the conclusion that the plaintiff is entitled for the relief as sought for and the suit has to be decreed accordingly. ***Hence, this court answered Point No.1 in the Affirmative.***

11. Point No.2: In view of my findings on point No.1, this court proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The suit filed by the plaintiff is hereby decreed with costs.

It is declared that the plaintiff's father and mother name is **C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary" instead of "Loordh Anandan.C.J" and "Arokya Mary"**

Further the defendants are directed to make necessary changes in the school records of plaintiff by inserting the plaintiff's father and mother name as **C.J.Jayaraju" and "Arikyamary" instead of "Loordh Anandan.C.J" and "Arokya Mary"** as per the required procedure under law.

Hence, the plaintiff is hereby directed to take paper publication in leading news paper within one month from the date of the receipt of the certified copy of this Judgment and thereafter, the defendants are directed to incorporate the said changes in their records and then issue a certified copy of the same to the plaintiff by collecting requisite fee from the plaintiff.

Draw decree accordingly.
