

The present suit is filed by the plaintiffs against the defendant seeking relief of permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule property. Along with suit plaintiffs also maintained application u/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC seeking ad-interim temporary injunction restraining the defendant, his men, agents, workers, or any one acting and claiming under him by interfering with the plaintiffs' peaceful possession and enjoyment of suit schedule property till disposal of the suit.

In support of their contention, the plaintiffs have produced several documents pertaining to suit schedule property. I have perused the averments made in the affidavit, plaint and documents relied by the plaintiffs. On perusal of RTC, mutation register extract prima faice appears that plaintiffs are in possession of suit property. Hence, I am of considered opinion that at this point of time if the exparte T.I. order is not granted then the very purpose for which the relief is sought will not survive for consideration. Hence, it is just

and necessary in the interest of justice to grant the exparte T.I. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

**ORDER**

The defendant, his men, agents, workers, or any one acting and claiming under him by interfering with the plaintiffs' peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit schedule property by way of ad-interim temporary injunction till next date of hearing.

Office shall issue exparte T.I. Order if plaintiffs have complied the mandatory provision U/o 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC and Issue Process through ordinary service as well as RPAD if furnished.

Issue summons and notice of I.A. to the defendant by 30.05.2024
