

**ORDER ON BAIL APPLICATION
FILED BY ACCUSED No.1**

Accused No.1 has filed this bail application U/s. 437 of Cr.P.C. seeking release on bail.

2. Accused No.1 in the application has stated that, he is innocent and has tenable and valid grounds. The offences are not punishable with imprisonment life or death. That the Accused is permanent resident within the jurisdiction of this court. Accused is ready to give surety for his release and under take to appear before the court on every date of hearing. The Accused is law abiding citizen having good regard for law. The Accused is ready to obey the conditions that may be imposed by this court. Hence, prayed to allow the application.

3. Learned APP has filed objection to the bail application contending alleged offences are non-bailable in nature. If the accused is released on bail there are chances of the accused person absconding and the accused persons will tamper the prosecution witnesses. Hence, prayed to dismiss the application.

4. From the above facts the following points that arise for my consideration:

1) Whether Accused No.1 is entitled for bail?

2) What order ?

5. My findings on the above said points are as under:

6. POINT No.1: This case is registered against Accused No. 1 for the offenses punishable under section 354, 504 and 506 of IPC in the year 2011,

7. Perusal of order sheet shows Accused No. 1 has repeatedly jumped bail conditions and therefore was taken custody on 12.08.2014. Subsequently he was released on 16.10.2014. Again he jumped bail conditions and was secured on 27.11.2025 by issuing proclamation. Since then he is in custody.

8. In this case the trial has not progressed. Evidence of even 1 witness is not recorded as Accused No. 1 was absconding. Therefore allowing the application on the assurance of the Accused that he

will attend the court on all dates of hearing is not believable.

8. Till the evidence of important witnesses is recorded it is necessary to curtail the liberty of Accused in view of repeated disregard to undertaking given by him. Hence this court proceeds to pass the following:

ORDER

The bail application filed by Accused No.1 U/s. 437 of Cr.P.C. is hereby dismissed.

JC of Accused No. 1 is extended until next date.

Jail Authorities are directed to produce Accused No. 1 through VC on next date of hearing.

Issue intimation to JA authorities through mail.

Issue NBW against CW1, 2, and issue summons to CW 6, 8 and 9.
