

**CASE CALLED OUT  
BEFORE LOK ADALATH.**

Accused is present and submit that he is ready to plead guilty. The consequences of getting plead guilty is explained to the accused person, even though he pleaded guilty. The offences charged against the accused person is punishable U/Sec. 92(O) and (R) of KP Act.

The charge-sheet copy is furnishes to the accused as per Sec. 230 of BNSS-2023.

The substance of the accusation is orally read-over and explained to the accused. Accused is pleaded guilty of the offences. I am satisfied that the plead of guilt is free from any force, coercion or undue influence.

Acting U/Sec. 275 of BNSS-2023., the accused person found guilty, hence the accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 92(O) and (R) of KP Act and sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 50/- in default to undergo S.I. for 2 days.
