

The complainant has filed an application U/s 156(3) of Cr.P.C., annexed with an affidavit and prayed to direct the concerned Kodihalli Police Station to investigate the matter under Sec.156(3) of Cr.P.C.

The said complaint is annexed with an affidavit.

Heard the counsel for complainant.

On perusal of the complaint and the averments that has been raised by the complainant. It has come to the notice of this court that initially the complainant had approached the concerned CPI of Kodihalli Police Station and has filed the first informant statement, the same is received by the concerned police, but no steps have been taken with that regard. Hence, the complainant has approached this court.

The Complainant has filed the present complaint U/Sec.200 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable U/Sec.498A, 304B, 313, 314, 323, 324, 325, 504 and 506 of IPC r/w Sec.3 and 4 of D.P Act against the Accused No.1 to 6 and filed an application U./Sec.156(3) of Cr.P.C. along with an affidavit praying to refer the matter for investigation to the concerned jurisdictional Police.

Heard the complainant and perused the materials available on records and the complainant has also furnished certain documents to substantiate his averments.

Further, in pursuance of the same and in due consideration of the materials on record at this stage of the case and in due consideration of the decisions rendered by the ***Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Priyanka Srivastav and another V/s State of U.P. and others*** reported in ***(2015) 6 SCC 287*** and in ***Babu Venkatesh and others V/s State of Karnataka and another*** reported in ***2022 Live Law (SC) 181***. This court is of the opinion that the said matter has to be referred for investigation Under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C.

Hence, the above said Private Complaint is referred to the C.P.I. of Kodihalli Police Station for the investigation Under Sec.156(3) of Cr.P.C. against Accused No.1 to 6.
