

The instant I.A. No. III U/o 3 R 2 R/w sec. 151 of CPC has been filed by the applicant come SPA holder of plaintiff seeking permission to prosecute the case on behalf of the plaintiff in this case. Copy of SPA is annexed with the application and vakalath is filed by Sri.SVV.

I have perused the reasons assigned in the affidavit accompanying with application.

It is settled that party to suit can prosecute or defend the case through recognized agent, pleader or power of attorney holder unless law so requires his personal appearance as per order 3 rule 2 of CPC.

The defendant has well opportunity to testify varsity of deposition which will be adduced by the holder and shaken his credibility during the course of cross examination. Therefore, I proceed to pass following:

**ORDER**

IA U/o 3 R 2 of CPC filed by the applicant is hereby allowed.

Thereby the applicant cum SPA holder of the plaintiff is accorded permission to contest the matter on behalf of the plaintiff as prayed for.

The plaintiff shall lead plaintiff evidence on next date of hearing without fail.
