

The complainant has filed an application U/s 156(3) of Cr.P.C., annexed with an affidavit and prayed to direct the concerned Kodihalli Police Station to investigate the matter under Sec.156(3) of Cr.P.C.

The said complaint is annexed with an affidavit.

Heard the counsel for complainant.

On perusal of the complaint and the averments that has been raised by the complainant. It has come to the notice of this court that initially the complainant had approached the concerned CPI of Kodihalli Police Station and has filed the first informant statement, the same is received by the concerned police, but no steps have been taken with that regard. Hence, the complainant has approached this court.

The Complainant has filed the present complaint U/Sec.200 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable U/Sec. 323, 324, 117, 420, 441, 504, 494 and 120B r/s Sec. 149 of IPC against the Accused persons and filed an application U./Sec.156(3) of Cr.P.C. along with an affidavit praying to refer the matter for investigation to the concerned jurisdictional Police.

Heard the complainant and perused the materials available on records and the complainant has also furnished certain documents to substantiate her averments.

However, the contents of the application and the matter therein reflects that, the alleged offences also include U/s 494 of IPC which cannot be referred for investigation U/s 156(3) of Cr.P.C and also the complaint does not reflect the exact date of the alleged incident. Further it is to be noted that in pursuance to the other factors on record the documents filed by the complainant reflects the case been registered bearing C.C No.15580/2021 before the Hon'ble 27th ACMM Court, Bengaluru. Hence, in pursuance to the present matter on hand, it would be just and appropriate to place the matter for sworn statement which would give an opportunity for

the complainant to substantiate her case on hand.

Hence, the said application in pursuance to the said observation made above does not deserve to be allowed. Accordingly the same stands rejected.

Complainant is directed to lead her sworn statement with substantial documents in support of the same.
