Examination in Chief by learned APP:

I was working from 2016-2021 at Community Health centre, Sathanuru.

On 19.07.2019 at about 12.20 PM when I was in the said community health center a patient by Name Nagamma W/o Bheemegowda was brought to the said health center by her Son in law Lokesh with history of assault stating she was assaulted on 18.07.2019 at about 8.30 PM. I examined her and found Two injuries.

One was lacerated wound over right Palmar surface of the hand from base of right ring finger about 2 to 3 c.m long and another injury i.e., lacerated wound over the right middle finger palmar surface about 2 cm long. In my opinion these injuries are in simple in nature and can be caused by blunt or sharp object.

The patient stated she was assaulted by wooden piece.

As the patient had injury on her hand where small bones are present I have referred to orthopedician at General Hospital, KKP.

I have issue wound certificate to IO.

Witness on seeing a wound certificate identifies her signature and states that it is the said wound certificate. Hence the said wound certificate is marked as Ex.P5 and the signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P.5(a).

The above injuries can happen if a person is assaulted with M.O. 1 .

Cross examination by Learned counsel for Accused Sri. KNG:

Police had not accompanied said patient. Patient had not brought any police notice. It is true to suggest that I have not mentioned the colour of injury or the duration of the wound certificate. It is false to suggest that I have not mentioned the direction of the wound in the wound certificate. It is true to suggest that I have not mentioned as to who assaulted the patient in the wound certificate. It is true to suggest that Injury No.1 in Ex.P5 can happen if one comes in contact with sharp glass pieces, wire or falls on sharp object. It is true to suggest that injury No. 2 in Ex.P5 can happen if a person falls on the ground by giving support of his hand. It is false to suggest that I have issued false wound certificate at the request of IO.
