ORDERS ON I.A. NO. 1

The plaintiff has filed the present suit against the defendants for partition and separate possession wherein IA. No.1 has filed under Order XXXII Rule 1 R/w Section 151 of CPC with a prayer to permit the plaintiff to appoint the defendant No.2 as guardian of the minor defendant No.4.

Perused the affidavit annexed to the present application. In the present case the defendant No.4 is being the minor, as such it is necessary to appoint a guardian to proceed the case on behalf of the minor defendant No.4. The defendant No.2 is none other than the mother of minor defendant No.4, as such she is the natural guardian to the minor defendant No.4. Hence by considering the nature of the suit there are no grounds to reject the present application, I proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

I.A. No.1 filed Under Order 32 Rule 1 R/w Section 151 of CPC by the plaintiff is hereby allowed.

The defendant No.2 is appointed as guardian to the defendant No.4.

No order as to cost.

Issue suit summons and emergent notice on IA.No.2 to the defendants, the suit **summons of the defendant No.4 shall be served on her natural guardian defendant No.2, if sufficient PF is paid.**
