

The present suit is filed by the minor plaintiffs through their natural guardian mother Smt. Shobha, for partition and separate possession in the suit schedule property.

Along with suit, plaintiffs have maintained an application under order 32 Rule 3 of CPC seeking permission to institute the suit through natural guardian. Plaintiffs are minor children of Smt. Shobha and Sri. Basavaraju (second defendant). That Smt. Shobha is ready to act as a guardian to protect the interest of minor plaintiffs. Unless appointment of guardian, suit of the minor plaintiff is not maintainable. Therefore, being mother Smt. Shobha is permitted to act as guardian thereby prosecute the suit in order to protect interest of minor. Hence, I proceed to pass following:

ORDER

I.A. under order 32 Rule 3 of CPC
is allowed thereby natural guardian

Smt. Shobha is permitted to institute the suit on behalf of minor plaintiffs.

Issue emergent notice and suit summons to the defendants through ordinary service as well as RPAD if plaintiffs have taken proper steps in accordance with law.
