The case record has been received from the RPF Post/SGUJ. The Court has perused the complaint, memo of arrest, arrest report, personal search, confessional statement of the accused, PR bond and Prosecution report.

Upon examination of the Prosecution report, cognizance is taken.

Accused is present.

The accused is not represented by any Lawyer. On being asked the accused submits that he is financially incapable to engage advocate on his behalf. I explained him the provisions of the free legal aid available to the unrepresented accused persons. I asked him whether he desires to avail of free legal assistance. He refused to avail the assistance of Legal Aid services and prays for permit him to defend himself. The accused person by submitting separate petitions prayed for defend himself and pleaded guilty. Perused the record. Heard accused person in person on the point of pleading guilty. Considered. The accused has been heard in person on the point of pleading guilty.

Upon asked, the accused voluntarily expressed his willing to plead guilty in open Court. Considering his voluntary admission, he is permitted to plead guilty.

Accordingly, the substance of accusation, as revealed from the Prosecution report under section 162 of the Railways Act has been read over and explained to him. Upon being asked, the accused voluntarily pleaded guilty by stating "Doshi" (Guilty).

Since the plea is found to be voluntary, the same is accepted and acted upon. Therefore, the accused Arjun Sarkar is hereby convicted under section 275 of BNSS for the commission of offence punishable under section 162 of the Railways Act.

The accused has submitted that he belongs to a very poor family and is the sole earning member of his household. He has prayed for leniency in sentencing. The Court has considered his submission.

Hence it is

*ORDERED*

The accused person is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.300/- for the offence punishable under section 162 Rly Act. in default of payment of fine the convicted person shall suffer simple imprisonment for 07 days for the offence punishable u/s 162 of the Railways Act.

Seized articles, if any, be disposed of accordingly to law after the expiry of appeal period.

Let a copy of this order be given to the convict at free of cost and one copy be sent to the concern E.O for his information and necessary action & for report compliance immediately.

The case is disposed of in an uncontested form. Note in concerned register. BC -II to comply.
