

The present suit is filed by the plaintiff against the defendants seeking relief of permanent injunction in respect of suit schedule properties. Along with suit plaintiff also maintained application u/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC seeking ad-interim temporary injunction restraining the defendants, its agents, men or anybody, under or through them from interfering or interrupting peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule properties of the plaintiff pending disposal of the suit.

In support of his contention, the plaintiff has produced several documents pertaining to suit schedule property. I have perused the averments made in the affidavit, plaint and documents relied by the plaintiff. Hence, I am of considered opinion that at this point of time if the exparte T.I. order is not granted then the very purpose for which the relief is sought will not survive for consideration. Hence, it is just and necessary in the interest of justice to grant the exparte T.I. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

The defendants, their agents or anyone acting on behalf of the defendants are hereby restrained from interfering with the plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule properties by way of ad-interim temporary injunction till next date of hearing.

Office shall issue exparte T.I. Order if plaintiff has complied the mandatory provision U/o 39 Rule 3(a) of CPC and Issue Process through ordinary service as well as RPAD if furnished.

Issue summons and notice of I.A. to the defendants by 01.12.2023.
