Today, case was fixed for appearance of accused through warrant of arrest. Warrants of arrest issued against accused received back served through wife. Ld. Counsel for the complainant orally submitted that report is wrong and accused is avoiding appearance in the court and has full knowledge about the case and requested to take/adopt more coercive method to procure his presence. Request heard. This court also presumes that accused has full knowledge about the present case and intentionally avoiding his appearance in the court. As such, in order to avoid any further delay, time and energy, this court finds it proper to take/adopt more coercive method to procure the presence of the accused, so proclamation under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. requiring the accused to appear in person be issued for **20.09.2024**. The executing constable is directed to appear on **12.08.2024** for making his statement regarding proclamation of the accused. It is directed that while effecting the publication, the executing constable shall effect it as per the procedure mentioned in sub-Clause (a,b and c) of Section 82(2)(i) of Cr.P.C. the proclamation shall be published as follows:-

- (a) Is shall be publicly read in some conspicuous place of the town or village in which above named accused ordinarily resides:
- (b) It shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of house or homestead in which the said accused ordinarily resides or to some conspicuous place of such town or village.
- (c) A copy thereof shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the Court house.

Proclamation be got executed through SHO concerned and he is directed to appear in person on the date fixed if proclamation is not executed. Complainant is also directed to furnish the list of property of accused on **20.09.2024**.
