The Petitioner No.1 to 3 and Respondent No.1 to 3 and their respective counsels files joint compromise petition intimating compromise in the aforesaid matter. The parties hereto has filed the compromise petition along with the copy of their aadhar cards in lieu of their identification. The original aadhar cards to returned back to the parties after due verification.

On verification the parties hereto submit that they have entered into the compromise and they intend to settle the aforesaid matter as per the terms of settlement mentioned in joint compromise petition. The parties further submits that they have come here out of their own freewill and volition. The petitioner No.3 makes payment of Rs.20,00,000/- by way of cheque to respondent No.2 towards settlment.

I have perused the copy of preliminary decree and other

documents. The said documents appears to show that the Petitioner No.1 to 3 and Respondent No.1 to 3 are legally entitled to enter in to compromise and they are valid rights over the schedule property .

**On Perusal of the compromise petition, I am of the opinion that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be lawful, hence the same is accepted.**
