

L/A for plaintiff files IA No. 2 U/o 32 Rule 15 of CPC . The defendants submits no objections. Further on enquiry it is noticed that the proposed next friend Smt. Kenchamma is none other than the mother of plaintiff and she has no conflict of interest with plaintiff. Hence, IA N o. 2 filed by plaintiff is hereby allowed and Smt. kKenchamma is hereby appointed as next friend. Plaintiff's mother Smt. Kenchamma representing plaintiff is present. Defendant No.1 and 2 are present. Their respective counsels are present.

Learned adv. for plaintiff has filed the application U/o 32 rule 7 of CPC praying for permitting the plaintiffs natural guardian ie., mother Smt. Kenchamma to compromise the aforesaid matter on behalf of the minor plaintiff. She submits that the aforesaid matter is proposed to be settled and the terms of settlement is in the benefit of minor.

In view of the said application being unopposed and accompanied by pleader certificate, and in view of the said compromise being proposed the IA filed by plaintiff U/o 32 rule 7 of CPC is hereby allowed. Further the mother of the minor it seems does not have conflict of interest. The plaintiff and defendants No. 1 and 2 prays for referring the matter to Lok Adalath. In view of directions to this Court through TLSC vide letter No.TLSC/MGD.Ref:KSLSA/03/NLA/ 2026 dated : 08.04.2026 matter is referred to daily Lok-adalath. Senior Civil Judge and JMFC,. Magadi Case called out before daily lok-adalath. The plaintiff's mother i.e., the guardian and defendant No.1 and 2 and their respective counsels files joint compromise petition intimating compromise in the aforesaid matter. The parties hereto has filed the compromise petition along with the copy of their aadhar cards in lieu of their identification. The original aadhar cards to returned back to the parties after due verification.

On verification the parties hereto submit that they have entered into the compromise and they intend to settle the aforesaid matter as per the terms of settlement mentioned in joint compromise petition. The parties further submits that they have come here out of their own freewill and volition. The learned adv. for plaintiff Sri. VS files pleaders certificate on behalf of minor contending that the compromise arise between the parties is in the interest of minor. Learned adv. for

plaintiff Sri. VS submits that the minor is entitled a share in the schedule properties and the share is equitably allotted to the minor.

In view of the said submissions by learned adv. Sri. VS pleader certificate is taken on record. Learned adv. for plaintiff further submits that the compromise is in the interest of minor plaintiff. I have perused the copy of G.Tree, RTC,s registered partition deed and other documents. The said documents appears to show that the plaintiff and defendant No.1 and 2 are legally entitled to enter in to compromise and they are valid rights over the schedule property .

On Perusal of the compromise petition, I am of the opinion that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be lawful, hence the same is accepted.

Draw decree accordingly.

Office is directed refund the court fee as per law.
