It is submitted by Id. Counsel for the applicant/accused that marriage of younger sister of applicant/accused namely Priyanka is scheduled to be held on 24/05/2021 at M.K. Palace, Laxman Sahani Road, Near Gurudwara Road, Gaya, Bihar and applicant/accused being the eldest brother is required to make necessary arrangement and groundwork in view of preparation of marriage ceremony of his sister, wedding card of which is annexed with the bail application. He has further submitted that customs and rituals performed prior to marriage of the younger sister of applicant/accused are to be solemnized at her native place at Gaya, Bihar. Id. Counsel has further submitted that father of the applicant/accused is old aged person having difficulty in walking due to injuries received in accident in June 2019, is a heart patient and is vulnerable to be affected with corona virus. He has further submitted that applicant/accused was granted interim bail for four days vide order dated 26/09/2020 for appearing in Preliminary examination of Civil Services which liberty was not misused by him and he surrendered before the jail authorities after expiry of interim bail. Id. Counsel has further submitted applicant/accused is ready to abide by all terms and conditions which may be imposed by this court while granting bail and is ready to furnish sound surety to the satisfaction of the Court. He has lastly prayed for grant of interim bail for one month.

On the other hand, Id. Addl. Ld. Counsel for the complainant has submitted that uncle of complainant has expired and he has gone to Bihar and will come back after 7 days.

It is submitted by Id. Counsel for the applicant that the complainant has levelled allegation against the applicant that he was present at the spot when on Pollard fired upon the complainant. He has further submitted that the contents of the FIR are false and concocted and the story has been cooked-up only in order to falsely implicate the applicant, however, it is admitted fact that from the contents of FIR that the present applicant neither fired upon the applicant nor he uttered a single word to the complainant. He has further submitted that no active role has been assigned to the applicant and there is nothing that other co-accused persons have shared any common intention with the Pollard. He has further submitted that applicant has no concern with the complainant or Pollard, has no previous enmity with the complainant, who has falsely implicated him on the instance of other persons. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant was not present at the alleged spot at the relevant time and is in possession of CCTV footage of relevant time period in this regard. He has further submitted that police is now acting in mechanical manner and want to arrest the applicant in present case in connivance with the complainant. Ld. Counsel has further submitted that applicant is ready to provide the CCTV footage but police is not paying any heed to the said effect. It is submitted by Id. Counsel for the applicant that the complainant has also apprised the IO that the present applicant was not amongst those persons who were involved in the incident. He has further submitted that applicant is ready to join the investigation as and when required by the IO or Court and undertakes to abide by all conditions, which may be imposed by the Court while granting anticipatory bail to him. He has lastly prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant.

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Ld. Counsel for the complainant has submitted that there is a DD regarding the fact that the applicant was not present at the time of incident and his name was taken by the complainant due to some misunderstanding.

IO has submitted that DD entry was lodged after 1½ months and during the said period, neither the complainant party nor the applicant has raised any objection qua taking of name of the applicant by the complainant due to some misunderstanding. IO has further submitted that there is no CCTV footage to the incident and the alleged CCTV footage is of some other place.

On the other hand, Id. Addl. PP for the State has objected to the grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant. He has submitted that this applicant is specifically named in the FIR and there is no possibility that he has been falsely implicated in the present matter.

Heard. The complainant has specifically named the present applicant in the FIR and the prior version of the complainant at this stage is more relevant. This fact is also important that the complainant kept mum for 1½ months which raises serious doubt and there is possibility of threatening of the complainant by the applicant. No mini trial can be conducted at this stage. Keeping in view the seriousness of the offences and also in view of these facts and circumstances, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out. Hence, the present bail application is dismissed and is disposed of accordingly.
