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J U D G M E N T

1. This is a case charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Kasaba Police Station in Crime No: 644 /2016 alleging commissions of offences punishable under sections 279, 338 of Indian Penal Code & sec. 3(1) r/w 181 of MV Act.

2. The prosecution case is that on 26/08/2016 at about 10.30 hours, accused rode the motor cycle bearing registration No: KL 9 AK 7705 through

Palakkad – Pollachi State highway in a most rash and negligent manner, so as to endanger human life without having any valid driving license. When the vehicle reached at Para junction, it hit on CW1 and sustained grievous injuries. With the above allegations accused is alleged to have committed the above mentioned offences.

3. Upon taking cognizance summons was issued to the accused. On his appearance through counsel, copies of relevant prosecution records were furnished to him in compliance of sec. 207 of Cr.P.C

4. Thereupon particulars of offence were read over and explained to accused to which he pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that his plea is made voluntary.

5. Considering the nature of offences committed I am of the view that sentenced to imposing fine would meet the ends of justice.

6. In the result, accused is found guilty, convicted and sentenced to pay fine of Rs,1000/- under sec. 279 of IPC, IDSI for two weeks, and also sentenced to pay fine of Rs, 1000/- under sec. 338 of IPC, IDSI for two weeks. Rs. 500/- under sec. 3(1) r/w 181 MV Act. IDSI for one week.
