an offence punishable under Sec.12(a) of Maharashtra Prevention of
Gambling Act and within my cognizance.

ORDER

Accused is present before me today. He is charged for offence punishable under section 12(a) of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act. His plea was recorded and particulars were explained to them in vernacular to which they pleaded guilty. I explained him about consequences of pleading guilty. He was given time for reflection. He continued with their voluntariness to plead guilty. I verified and examined that his plea is without influence or pressure. His plea being voluntary, I accept the same.

Heard Ld.APP and Ld.Adv. for the accused. Ld.Adv for accused prayed for leniency in awarding sentence as he is the sole earner of the family. Considering the nature of offence, family dependency of the

accused and in the interest of justice, I am of the opinion that imposing fine would be appropriate sentence, hence I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The accused **Ashok Bhimrao Pawar**, is hereby convicted for offence punishable under section 12(a) of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act vide section 252 of Code of Criminal Procedure and he is sentenced to imprisonment till rising of the Court and pay fine of **Rs.300/-(Rupees Three Hundred only)** and in default to undergo simple imprisonment for **two days**.

2. The bail bonds of the accused stand canceled, if furnished.

3. Seized cash amount of Rs.300/- be credited to the State Government after appeal period is over. Remaining muddemal carbon copy, pen and paper chit being worthless, be destroyed after appeal period is over.
