This petition is coming for hearing before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.R.Aswin, Advocate for the Petitioner/Accused and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent and this Court made the following

ORDER

This petition is filed U/s.483 of BNSS for seeking bail.

Prosecution case is that the FIR was registered as against the Petitioner/Accused for the alleged offences punishable U/Ss.296(b), 118(2) and 351(3) of BNS @ 296(b) and 103(1) of BNS for the alleged occurrence and the Petitioner/Accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 05.07.2026.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has contended that the Respondent Police have registered an FIR as against the Petitioner/Accused and he is falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged in FIR. He further stated that the fact of the case is that the Petitioner/Accused is permanently residing in the above said address for the past 33 years. They are residing in the same village. There is family dispute between the parties. The deceased came to the Petitioner's house and carrying a wooden log. At the time of the incident, the deceased was in a state of heavy voluntary intoxication. At the time some quarrel was happened between them. A sudden un-premeditated verbal altercation broke out between the parties. That the deceased, losing complete self-control due to intoxication, picked up a heavy wooden log

and violently attempted to launch a life-threatening physical attack on the petitioner. So there is no fault on the side of the Petitioner/Accused. As a result the deceased sustained head injury and died. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Petitioners/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 33 days.

The Learned Public Prosecutor contended that the Petitioner/Accused is in judicial custody for the past 33 days only. As per FIR, there is specific overtact against him. The offence is grave in nature. The investigation has not yet been completed. Hence, he has serious objection to release the Petitioners/Accused on bail.

Heard both sides.

Considering the rival submissions of both sides and considering the strong objection of the learned Public Prosecutor and facts and circumstances of the case and considering that the offence is grave in nature and also considering the version of FIR and the investigation has not yet been completed, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioners/Accused.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
