

**CASE CALLED OUT BEFORE**  
**NATIONAL LOK-ADALATH**

The Petitioner and respondent have filed joint memo.

The petitioner has appeared and submitted that, he is ready to enter into the compromise. He has produced the original documents with regard to his date of birth .

The documents shown by the petitioner are verified and same are found satisfactory.

In view of the joint memo filed by the parties, the petition under Section 13(3) of registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 is hereby allowed.

In the case of Devamma V/s Registrar, Births and Deaths Mysore reported in AIR 2004 KARNATAKA 221 **the Hon'ble High Court has observed that, the correctness or other wise of the date of birth concerned is totally irrelevant in the proceedings under Section 13 (3) of Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 and only the fact of birth is relevant.**

Hence, the respondent is hereby directed to enter the date of birth of the petitioner by name **Sri. Mohammed Inayath S/o Late Mohammed Nazeer,**

R/at New Masjid Mohalla, Magadi Town,  
in the concerned register **as**  
**01.07.1978** after collecting the fee in  
that behalf.

This entry shall not be the  
conclusive proof regarding the date of  
birth of petitioner, if it is disputed in  
any criminal case of litigation.

It is further clarified that this  
order is only applicable to produce  
before the respondent Office to enter the  
date of birth and it is not valid for any  
other purpose.
