

## **ORDER ON I.A.NO.I**

That, the plaintiff has filed this suit for declaration and permanent injunction against the defendants and also filed I.A.No.1 U/o.XXXIX Rule 1 & 2 r/w Sec.151 of CPC with a prayer that the defendants, their agents, servants, family members, power of attorney holders followers, henchmen or anybody claiming through them from not to interfere with the plaintiff peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule property till disposal of suit.

2.Perused the plaint averments, I.A.No.I, affidavits annexed thereto and documents produced along with plaint. From perusal of the same, it appears that, the plaintiff has made out a prima-facie case at this juncture. That, if the notice on I.A.No.I is ordered to be issued before granting injunction, the object of granting Ex-parte injunction would be defeated by delay in service of notice and irreversible circumstance may arise. I am satisfied to grant Ex-parte injunction. Hence, I proceed

to pass the following;

**ORDER**

The Defendants, their agents, servants or anybody acting on his behalf is hereby restrained from interfering over the plaintiff peaceful possession and enjoyment over the suit schedule property in any manner as shown in the plaint.

This Ex-parte injunction order will be in force till next date of hearing.

Office is hereby directed to issue certified copy of this order, after compliance of order XXXIX Rule 3 of CPC and requisite P.F is paid.

Issue Suit Summons and notice on I.A.No.1 to defendants.
