**ORDER ON PETITION FILED U/SEC. 13(3) OF THE
REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS & DEATHS ACT OF 1969.**

This is a petition filed under section 13(3) of the Registration of the Births and Deaths Act of 1969. It is stated in the petition that, father of petitioner deceased by name **Sri.Narasimha Naik S/o Late Rama Naik., who died on 18.07.1990 at Karlahalli Village, Madbal Hobli, Magadi Taluk, Bangalore South(Ramanagara) District,** and the information of death was not intimated to the respondents due to lack of knowledge and by oversight.

2. The respondent has issued an endorsement stating that there is no entry regarding the date of death in the concerned register. Accordingly, present petition is filed for proper direction to the respondent to make an entry regarding the death of father of petitioner.

3. The respondent is placed exparte as they remained absent even after receipt of notice. Paper publication was issued in a local Kannada morning daily news paper calling objections to this petition from the interested persons if any. However, no one has appeared before the Court and contested the petition.

4. Heard the counsel for the petitioners.



5. The points that would arise for my consideration are ;

1. Whether the petitioner is entitled for the relief as prayed in the petition ?
2. What order?

6. My findings to the above said points are as under;

Point No.1 : **In the Affirmative.**

REASONS

7. **Point No.1:** - The petitioner has got examined before the Court as PW1, who filed affidavit in lieu of her examination in chief, wherein she has reiterated the averments of the petition. The petitioner has produced the Non-availability certificate issued by **The Tahasildhar & Registrar of Birth and Death**, which is marked as Ex.P1, Notarized copy of Genealogical tree as Ex.P2, Tax Paid Receipt as Ex.P3 and paper publications in **Suvarna Rajya & Hosadigantha** Kannada daily morning News papers which are marked as Ex.P4 & Ex.P5 respectively. The evidence of petitioner and the contents of petition remain unchallenged by the respondents. Hence, there is no



controversy raised about the date of death. Further, there are no reasons to disbelieve the contentions of the petitioner. Accordingly, I hold on perusal of Ex.P.1 that, it has become necessary to issue direction to the respondents to make an entry regarding the date of death as prayed in the petition. Hence, I answer this point in the Affirmative.

8. Point No.2 :- In the light of the discussion made above and for the aforesaid reasons, I proceed to pass the following ;

ORDER

The petition filed by the petitioner under Sec 13(3) of the Registration of the Births and Deaths Act of 1969 is hereby allowed.

The respondent is hereby directed to cause entry regarding the death of **Sri.Narasimha Naik S/o Late Rama Naik., who died on 18.07.1990 at Karlahalli Village, Madbal Hobli, Magadi Taluk, Bangalore South (Ramanagara) District**, in the concerned register after collecting necessary fees, as required under law.
