This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Thiru.M.Perilavan, Advocate for the petitioner and of Thiru.R.Rajprasanna, Public Prosecutor for the State and after hearing the arguments of either side and on perusal of available records, this court passed the following....

ORDER

The petitioner/Accused has filed this Petition filed U/s. 483 of BNSS Praying to enlarge him on bail for the alleged offence u/s. 118(1), 126(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS altered into 109, 118(1), 126(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS in Cr.No.276/2026 of Chinnasalem PS. The petitioner/Accused was remanded on 09.08.2026.

The Learned counsel for the Petitioner/Accused would state that the petitioner is an innocent person and not in any way connected with the above alleged offenses, that the investigation is almost over, that he is having a permanent abode, that the question of absconding or tampering the witness will not arise, that he will abide any conditions, if imposed by this court in the bail order, that he was remanded on 09.08.2026 and is in custody for 08 days and prays for bail

The Learned Public Prosecutor has filed the written objection stating that the Petitioner/Accused along with co-accused abused the defacto-complainant in filthy language, assaulted him by Knife on his left thigh and left elbow caused grievous injury and that the defacto-complainant is still taking treatment at the Government Hospital, Kallakurichi and the investigation is pending. Hence prays for dismissal of the petition.

Heard Both sides. Records perused. The case was registered against the petitioner/accused for the offences punishable u/s. 118(1), 126(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS altered into 109, 118(1), 126(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS. From the FIR it is seen that on 06.08.2026 at 02.00p.m., the petitioner along with two others abused the defacto-complainant in filthy language, assaulted him by Knife on his left thigh and left elbow caused grievous injury and that the defacto-complainant is still taking treatment at the Government Hospital, Kallakurichi and the investigation is pending. Considering the gravity of the offences and the conduct of the petitioner, no prima-facie case infavour of the petitioner being made out and that the investigation is pending, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/accused, at this stage, would tamper the investigation and may also result into tampering of the evidence. **Hence, the petition is dismissed.**
