ORDER

1. This petition has been filed u/s.483(b) of B.N.S.S., to modify the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.52/2026 dated 13.05.2026.

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3. It has been stated in the petition that the petitioner has been granted bail by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.52/2026 by order dated 13.05.2026 with a condition that the petitioner shall appear and sign before the Theni Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., and 5.00 p.m., for 30 days. As per the direction of this Court, the petitioner had complied the condition for the past 12 days and the petitioner is employed in the Electricity Board Department and it is difficult for him to appear before the Theni Police Station. Hence, the petitioner had came up with this petition to modify the order imposed on bail by this Court to Respondent Police Station instead of Theni Police Station.

4. The respondent filed an objection stating that the petitioner abiding the condition from 20.05.2026 to 01.06.2026 for the past 12 days. However, if the condition is modified, there is a likelihood of the petitioner committing further offences in future.

5. Considering the reasons stated in the petition seeking for modification and considering the fact that the petitioner duly complied with the condition from 20.05.2026 to 01.06.2026 for the past 12 days and in view of the difficulties expressed, this court is inclined to modify the condition and the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., and 5.00 p.m., for the remaining period of 18 days.



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In the result, this condition is modified and the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.52/2026 dated 13.05.2026 **is modified and the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 a.m., and 5.00 p.m., for the remaining period of 18 days**, thereafter he should appear before the court concerned on receipt of summon except the above modification, the other conditions imposed holds good.
