Plaintiff files hazira.

Now the temporary injunction petition is taken up for hearing exparte against the defendants.

Having heard and considered the submission made by the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff and on perusal of the temporary injunction petition and other relevant documents, it is revealed that the suit property, in past, belonged to Bishnupada Majhi. He executed a lease deed being no. 1697 dated 22.04.2002 in favour of the plaintiff. Plaintiff also paid rent. Since then the plaintiff is in possession of the suit property. After the death of Bishnupada Majhi, defendants inherited the suit property and mutated their names. Defendants also causing disturbance in the peaceful possession of the plaintiff over the suit property. Defendants are also trying to grab the suit property by dispossessing the plaintiff.

After receiving notice, defendants appeared but subsequently he did not turn up. Defendants also did not file any objection against the ad-interim injunction passed against him vide order no. 2 dated 12.09.22. From the conduct of the defendants it is established that by the said order of ad-interim injunction defendants did not sustain any injury.

Considering above, I find no impediment to allow the the ad-interim order of injunction as final.

Hence, it is
ORDERED

that the defendants are directed not to dispossess the plaintiff from the suit property and also not to cause any disturbance upon the possession of the plaintiff over the suit property till the disposal of this suit.

Thus the petition for temporary injunction is hereby disposed of.
