Both parties has filed hazira through their Ld. Advocates.

The case record is taken up for hearing of the injunction petition.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs filed a petition for extension of ad interim order supported by affidavit.

The petition reveals that the plaintiffs are in possessing the suit property and lot no 1 was a vested land wherein Kamala Mallick got 10 decimals and she died leaving behind her son Narayan Mallick. Lot no 2 was allotted in favor of Gostha Mallick and after his demise his son Ganesh and Kartick Mallick inherited the same. Lot no 3 was allotted to Bhupen Kotal and after his death Amal and Bimal Kotal inherited the same.

On the other hand the Ld Advocate for the defendant has objected the petition by filing a written objection and states that the suit property is adjacent to defendant's plot and is classified as Pukur and states that it is the proforma defendant who is creating interruption in the possession of the Main Defendant and so he has filed and due to that reason a case in the executive Court against them is pending and as plaintiffs are close relatives of proforma defendant, they are intentionally trying to harass and made up a false story and has filed this case.

Heard the Ld. Advocates for the parties.

At the time of hearing, Ld. Advocates representing both sides submitted that an order of status quo be granted till disposal of the suit on consent of both sides so that the suit be expeditiously disposed off after trial on contest.

Accordingly, after hearing both the sides, this court is of the view that in the interest of justice and upon consent of both the sides an order of status quo be granted till the final disposal of the suit. The plaintiffs are in possession of the suit plot.

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Hence, it is,

Ordered.

that the prayer for temporary injunction is allowed on consent.

Both the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* in respect of the suit property as on today and not to change the nature and character of it till final disposal of the suit.
